Description of the workshop:

The 18th Fish Vaccination Workshop was held in Wageningen, the Netherlands, from the 30th April to the 1st May 2017. The objective of this workshop was to provide participants with advanced knowledge, both theoretical and practical, on the immune system of fish.

During the workshop the latest insights in the evolution of the immune system and, in particular, immune modulation, host defence against pathogens and vaccination were discussed. Several partners from ParaFishControl participated in this event presented the latest results obtained within the project. Among others:
