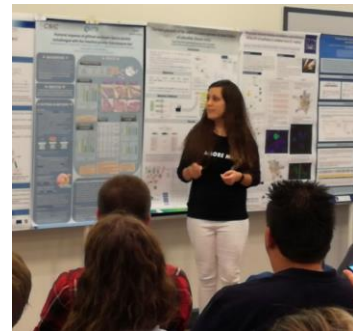

Description of the workshop:

The 19th Fish Immunology Workshop was held in Wageningen, the Netherlands, from the 29th April to the 3rd of May 2018. The objective of this workshop was to provide participants with advanced knowledge, both theoretical and practical, on the immune system of fish.

During the workshop the latest insights in the evolution of the immune system and, in particular, modulation of fish immune responses, were discussed.
